Keeping Holly Hills Beautiful

The Holly hills Beautification Committee met for its inaugural meeting on Nov. 29. We outlined three objectives: planning a community social event that would also incorporate recycling education; trash pick-up and reduction strategies; and increasing overall neighborhood recycling, but specifically in the park.

The committee is currently considering spring dates for the community event to be held in Carondelet Park, perhaps coinciding with Earth Day or the Operation Bright Side clean-up. 




