The Flora Conservancy of Carondelet Park

The Flora Conservancy continues to work on the boathouse and this fall saw the beginning of what is going to be a spectacular landscape and facial renovation. The Conservancy met in October and planted close to 200 rose bushes and hundreds of butterfly bushes to begin Phase I of the landscape design. Next spring the Boathouse will be painted with complementary colors chosen to accentuate the landscape design plan.


